The HIRA Journey

In 2016, Alhamdulillah, with the grace of Allah, HIRA Institute first opened the **Weekend and After School Programs** at Guiding Light Islamic Center at 6500 Six Mile Lane, Louisville, KY 40218.

In 2017, we were able to launch the **Summer Program** at the Louisville Islamic Center for Compassion at 4007 River Rd, St Matthews, KY 40207 and the **HIRA Musallah** at 1596 10th St, Jeffersonville, IN 47130.

In 2018, HIRA Institute launched the **Part-Time Tahfeedh Program** in collaboration with Nur Islamic School of Louisville, 6500 Six Mile Lane, Louisville, KY 40218.. The students memorized Qur'an from 6:00 to 9:00 a.m. then joined normal classes at Nur Islamic School from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

In 2019, HIRA Institute established the **Full-Time Tahfeedh Program** at Guiding Light Islamic Center. This was the first and only full-time Tahfeedh Program in KY. The students had tahfeedh from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Then they had online secular education from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. through JCPS online and Calvert Learning.

In 2020, HIRA Institute moved the Full-Time Tahfeedh Program to the American Turkish Friendship Association, 4711 Progress Blvd. Students had tahfeedh from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Then in the afternoon, secular education from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. was taught by in person teachers. HIRA Institute also launched the first **Islamic High School in Kentucky** in the same location. AP classes were taught in conjunction with the University of California UC Scout Program.

For the 2020/2021 school year, HIRA Institute had 32 students. For the 2021/2022 school year, enrollment increased to 57. In May 2021, HIRA Institute graduated the first high school student who has since continued on to college at Jefferson Community and Technical College. HIRA Institute also **graduated the first Hafiz student** who was in Eighth Grade.

In May 2022, the school graduated two students. One student has received full scholarships, and the other completed high school in three years, and also completed the memorization of the Qur'an, Masha Allah. This year, with the help of Allah, we also purchased a new 35,000 sq. feet school facility.

In May 2023, by the grace of Allah, the school graduated four students. Three students received scholarships, and the last student enrolled in the HIRA Alimiyyah Program. Two students also completed the memorization of the Qur'an, Alhamdulillah. We also completed most of the renovations for the new campus.

This year we focused on organizational growth and and community impact to much success, Alhamdulillah.

Campus Project Updates

In 2022, we closed the deal on a new campus for \$650,000, Alhamdulillah.

We got started on the campus right away. The first thing we did was clean up.

Purchased and installed over 140 new windows. These windows display the 99 attributes of Allah on them, visible from the classroom and the streets.

Installed all new ceilings and walls. This included all new ceiling tiles and grids.



All the electric, fire and sprinkler systems were installed and updated to bring it up to the electric and fire code.

10 brand new state of the art HVAC systems were installed.



4 new bathrooms were installed, and there are a total of 14 new stalls, with new toilets, sinks, and granite countertops.

State of the art IT and security systems were setup and installed. This includes both audio and video security 24/7.

During December we completed painting. Our new countertops and speakers were just installed.

New Clothing and Bookstore was opened

New roofs are being installed with a new gutter system, Alhamdulillah, the work is done, but finishing touches are left.
