FIRST STAGE



QĀ'IDAH NŪRĀNIYYAH

Students are introduced to the basics of Qur'ānic recitation using the renowned Qā'idah Nūrāniyyah method. This level is specifically designed for beginners who may have little or no prior experience with Arabic Language or Qur'ānic reading. The curriculum includes the following:

- Arabic Script: Students learn the Arabic alphabet and its pronunciation, enabling them to recognize and correctly articulate each letter.
- Letter Joining: Basic rules of joining letters are taught to enable students to form simple words and read them fluently.
- Short Words and Phrases: Students practice reading short words and phrases from the Qur'ān, helping them build their reading skills and confidence.
- Simple Sūrahs: Students are introduced to simple and short Sūrahs from the Qur'ān, allowing them to experience the beauty of Qur'ānic verses early in their learning journey.



SECOND STAGE



NAẒIRAH: DEVELOPING PROFICIENCY IN QUR'ĀNIC READING WITH TAJWĪD

The term "Naẓirah" finds its origin in the Arabic language, signifying the act of looking into the Qur'ān and reciting its verses. In this pivotal phase of learning, students embark on a journey to cultivate proficiency in Qur'ānic reading, all while meticulously applying the intricate rules of Tajwīd. This stage focuses on nurturing not only the ability to recite the Qur'ān fluently but also recitation with the correct pronunciation, thereby enhancing their engagement with the divine words.

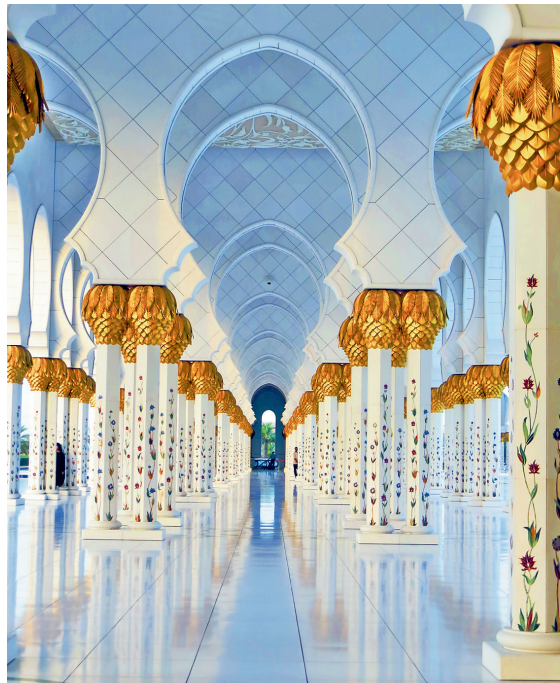

BASIC

In the introductory phase of Tajwīd, learners become familiar with essential rules governing proper Qur'ānic pronunciation. Focus is placed on mastering the correct articulation of Arabic letters and basic recitation techniques, setting the foundation for accurate Qur'ānic recitation.



INTERMEDIATE

As learners progress to the intermediate level, they delve deeper into the nuances of Tajwīd. This stage involves a comprehensive study of the distinct characteristics of Arabic letters, including points of articulation and the rules governing their interaction. Learners refine their pronunciation, striving for clarity and precision.



ADVANCED

At the advanced level, learners ascend to a higher realm of Tajwīd mastery. They navigate intricate rules that govern elongation, assimilation, and the correct application of various recitation techniques. This stage fosters a heightened awareness of pronunciation subtleties, ensuring an elevated level of recitation accuracy.



EXPERT

6 STAGES OF QUR'AN



2 AND LESS JUZ

Initiation Level: This phase marks the beginning of Qur'ānic memorization, encompassing the first 2 Juz. Students establish their foundational recitation and memorization techniques during this period.

3 TO 5 JUZ

Intermediate Attainment: As students progress to this phase, spanning Juz 3 to 5, their memorization skills mature. They delve deeper into Qur'ānic verses, refining their enunciation and understanding of memorizing Qur'ān.



6 TO 10 JUZ

Advanced Accomplishment: In this stage, covering Juz 6 to 10, students achieve an advanced level of memorization. They master a substantial portion of the Qur'ān, honing their ability to recite and retain verses with greater proficiency.

11 TO 20 JUZ

Progressive Mastery: Spanning Juz 11 to 20, this phase indicates significant memorization progress. Students navigate through a broader range of Qur'ānic content, enhancing their spiritual connection.





6 STAGES OF QUR'AN



COMPLETION EXCELLENCE

This pinnacle phase, covering Juz 20 to 30, represents the accomplishment of memorizing the entire Qur'ān. Students attain comprehensive proficiency, embodying the essence of the Qur'ānic teachings.

HIFẒ REVIEW

Retentive Reflection: The HifẒ Review stage involves reflective revision of entire Qur'ān. This ongoing process ensures the sustained retention and accuracy of Holy Qur'ān, reinforcing students' commitment to their mastery of the Qur'ān.



INTRODUCTION TO ALIMIYYAH

While a student is receiving their HifẒ, they are introduced to the Alimiyyah program, which continues the of understanding Qur'ān and learning to read and write the Arabic language.

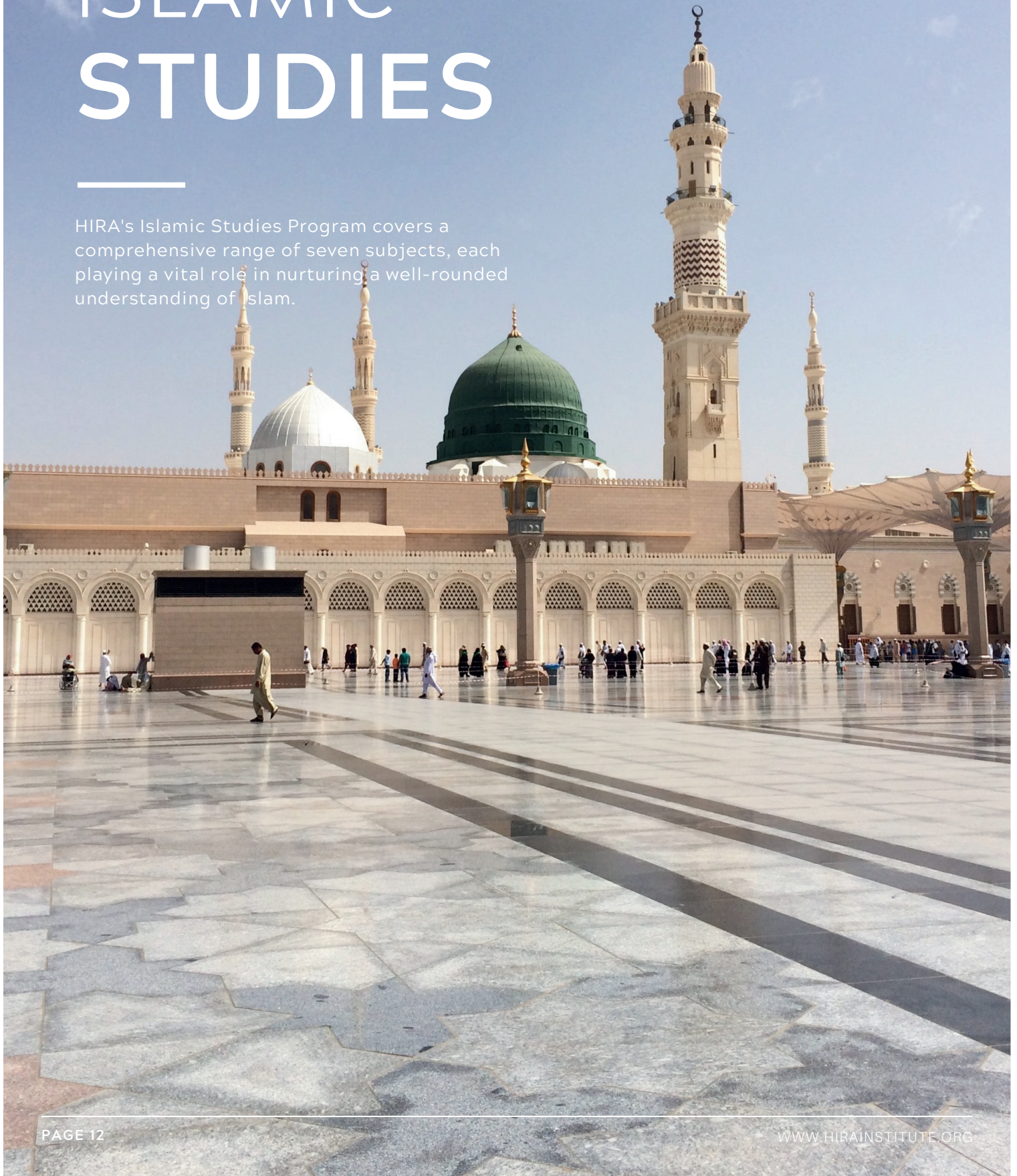

7 COMPREHENSIVE TOPICS

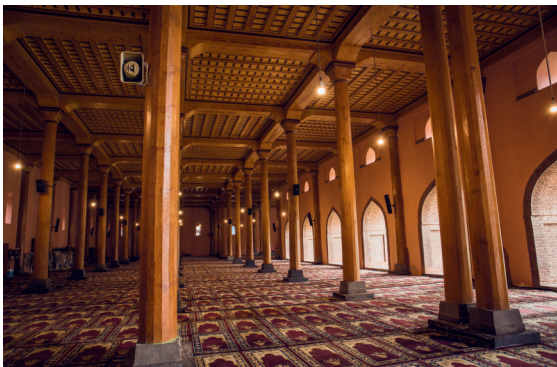


AQĀ'ID

Islamic creed, deals with the fundamental beliefs and tenets of Islam. Students study the core principles of faith, such as the belief in Allah, the Prophets, angels, the Day of Judgment, and predestination.

FIQH

The practical application of Islamic principles and laws in various aspects of daily life. Students learn the rulings and guidelines on matters such as prayer, fasting, charity, and other religious obligations.



SĪRAH

The study of Sīrah focuses on the life and character of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). Students learn about his exemplary conduct, leadership, and interactions, drawing inspiration from his noble character.

TĀRĪKH

Tārīkh refers to Islamic history. Students explore key events, developments, and personalities from the early days of Islam to understand the rich historical context that shaped the Muslim world.





7 COMPREHENSIVE TOPICS



AHĀDĪTH

Sayings, actions, and approvals of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). Students study the hadith literature to gain insights into the Prophet's teachings, which serve as a valuable source of guidance for Muslims.

AKHLĀQ

Akhlāq focuses on moral and ethical behavior. Students learn the importance of honesty, kindness, humility, and other virtues emphasized in Islam, aiming to embody these qualities in their lives.



ĀDĀB

Ādāb pertains to etiquette and manners, teaching students how to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the teachings of Islam. This subject emphasizes respect, empathy, and compassion in dealings with others.

By covering these seven subjects, the program equips students with a well-rounded understanding of Islam. This holistic approach helps students develop a deep appreciation for their faith, enabling them to lead exemplary lives in both their personal and social spheres.



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
