

Importance of Hira's Qur'an & Islamic Studies Program:


- Strong Qur'ānic Knowledge: Students develop a deep understanding of the Qur'ān, fostering a spiritual connection with its teachings.
- Preserving Islamic Heritage: The program ensures the timeless wisdom of the Qur'ān is passed down to the younger generation.
- Character Development: instill Islamic values, cultivate honesty, compassion, and empathy, fostering positive character traits.
- Community Building: The program creates a supportive community for families seeking to nurture Islamic education.
- Sense of Identity: Students gain confidence and a strong sense of belonging to their faith.
- Life Skills: Discipline, time management, and perseverance are instilled through routine.
- Enhanced Prayer: Memorizing Qur'ānic verses enriches the prayer experience, deepening the connection with Allah.

Qur'an Studies ! Level 1

Qā'idah Nūrāniyyah -Fundamentals of Recitation

In Level 1, students are introduced to the basics of Qur'ānic recitation using the renowned Qā'idah Nūrāniyyah method. This level is specifically designed for beginners who may have little or no prior experience with Arabic script or Qur'ānic reading. The curriculum includes the following:

- Arabic Script: Students learn the Arabic alphabet and its pronunciation, enabling them to recognize and correctly articulate each letter.
- Letter Joining: Basic rules of joining letters are taught to enable students to form simple words and read them fluently.
- Short Words and Phrases: Students practice reading short words and phrases from the Qur'ān, helping them build their reading skills and confidence.
- Simple Sūrahs: Students are introduced to simple and short Sūrahs from the Qur'ān, allowing them to experience the beauty of Qur'ānic verses early in their learning journey.

In Level 2, students progress to intermediate-level Qur'ānic Studies, where they focus on improving their recitation with basic Tajwīd rules. Additionally, they begin memorizing the 30th part (Juz 'Amma) of the Qur'ān, which contains some of the shorter chapters. The curriculum includes:

- Tajwīd Rules: Students delve deeper into Tajwīd, learning essential rules for correct pronunciation, elongation, and stopping at appropriate places during recitation.
- Juz 'Amma Memorization: Students memorize the selected Sūrahs from Juz 'Amma, which are frequently recited in daily prayers and are of immense spiritual significance.
- Application of Tajwīd: Students practice applying Tajwīd rules to their memorized portions, ensuring that their recitation is melodious and adheres to the proper pronunciation.



Qur'an Studies tevel 3


Level 3 marks the advanced stage of Qur'ānic Studies at HIRA's After School Program. Students deepen their understanding of Tajwīd rules, complete the recitation of the entire Qur'ān and memorize various Sūrahs of significance.

The curriculum includes:

- Advanced Tajwīd: Students are exposed to more intricate Tajwīd rules, enabling them to refine their recitation and achieve fluency in their understanding and application.
- Selected Sūrah Memorization: Students memorize longer Sūrahs from different parts of the Qur'ān, broadening their Qur'ānic knowledge and spiritual connection.
- Comprehensive Review: Students regularly review and revise their memorized portions, reinforcing their memorization.

Throughout all three levels, students receive personalized attention from experienced teachers who guide them on their Qur'ānic journey. The program emphasizes the importance of Qur'ān studies while instilling Islamic values, enabling students to reflect on the messages of the Qur'ān and apply them to their lives.








Seven Comprehensive Subjects

HIRA's After-School Islamic Studies Program covers a comprehensive range of seven subjects, each playing a vital role in nurturing a well-rounded understanding of Islam:

- 1. Aqā'id: Islamic creed, deals with the fundamental beliefs and tenets of Islam. Students study the core principles of faith, such as the belief in Allah, the Prophets, angels, the Day of Judgment, and predestination.
- 2. Ibādah: The practical application of Islamic principles and laws in various aspects of daily life. Students learn the rulings and guidelines on matters such as prayer, fasting, charity, and other religious obligations.
- 3. Sīrah: The study of Sīrah focuses on the life and character of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). Students learn about his exemplary conduct, leadership, and interactions, drawing inspiration from his noble character.
- 4. Tārīkh: Tārīkh refers to Islamic history. Students explore key events, developments, and personalities from the early days of Islam to understand the rich historical context that shaped the Muslim world.

- 5. Ahādīth: Sayings, actions, and approvals of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). Students study the hadith literature to gain insights into the Prophet's teachings, which serve as a valuable source of guidance for Muslims.
- 6. Akhlāq: Akhlāq focuses on moral and ethical behavior. Students learn the importance of honesty, kindness, humility, and other virtues emphasized in Islam, aiming to embody these qualities in their lives.
- 7. Ādāb: Ādāb pertains to etiquette and manners, teaching students how to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the teachings of Islam. This subject emphasizes respect, empathy, and compassion in dealings with others.

By covering these seven subjects, the program equips students with a well-rounded understanding of Islam, encompassing its spiritual, legal, historical, and ethical dimensions. This holistic approach helps students develop a deep appreciation for their faith, enabling them to lead exemplary lives in both their personal and social spheres.


